6. Guidelines / Directive issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India / High Court or any other court with reference to transportation of school children shall have to be complied with meticulously.
7. The salary of the staff will be paid through cheques.
8. The management will get their school inspected by the zonal Education Officer at least once during the academic session.
9. DEO/AEO/HM of the best school of the zone will be included in the Management Committee of the School.
10. The HM of the school will attend the meetings called by the zonal Education Officers from time to time.
11. If the schools violates the Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973, the Director (PE) is empowered to terminates the recognition of the school.

14. That the school shall comply with clause 14 of Order No. F.D/15/(56)/ACT/2009778 dated 11.02.2009 in r/o maintenance of DRF. School also ensure to follow FN-21 'Accounting by Schools' as issued by the institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) for proper accounting treatment.
15. That the annual return under rule 180 of DSER, 1973 shall be filed with the concerned Deputy Director of Education (District / Zone).
16. That in case of Provisional Recognition given to the school situated in non-confirming area, the recognition will be subject to the outcome of notification by Ministry of Urban Development Govt. of India, Delhi.
17. That Appointment of requisite teaching staff as per requirement and RRs laid down by DoE.
18. That the school shall get permission from the Competent Authority to run pre-school and pre-primary classes within three months of the issuance of this letter.
19. That the school shall comply with the provisions of Sections 17 (3) & 18 (5), Rules 176 & 177 of DSEAR, 1973 and order dated 15.12.1999, 10.05.2005, 11.02.2009, 16.04.2010 & 19.02.2016 dealing with the regulation of fee along with the subsequent orders issued by DoE from time to time.

21. That the violation of any instructions/orders/rules and regulations of the department, shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.

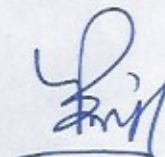
